**CRITERIA**  
**ANNUAL RECOGNITION AWARD**

In order to qualify for **THE BRIAN INGBER MEMORIAL FOUNDATION ANNUAL RECOGNITION AWARD**, the following criteria, established by the Awards Committee, shall be met:

1. The applicant must be enrolled as a senior in high school within Sullivan County.
2. The applicant must be a prospective June graduate in the year the award is being solicited and must be a student in good standing.
3. The applicant must exemplify the ideals of volunteerism, service within his/her school and community, be of good moral and ethical character, and be a well-rounded student. This award is available, for example, to any student that is seeking employment that demonstrates a commitment to community service or a student that is seeking to further their education in fields of study that will result in improving the quality of life in their community.
4. The applicant must secure an application form from his/her guidance office and must submit the completed application, a brief letter outlining the reason for consideration, and a letter of recommendation. All documents must be **typewritten or printed legibly** and signed by the guidance counselor.
5. The Awards Committee for The Brian Ingber Memorial Foundation will notify the guidance department if there should be a winner from that particular school. A check for up to \$1,000.00 will be mailed to the guidance department for the recipient and will be presented at graduation or a school awards program. It will be up to the respective school to determine where this presentation will be made.
6. The Committee may, in any given year and at its discretion, bestow a Recognition Award utilizing criteria in addition to, or other than, that which is outlined herein.
