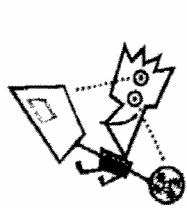


ARTS IN LITERATURE

MESSAGES IN MUSIC

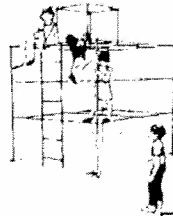
