Item 4: Why do you feel deserving of this scholarship?




Because her work with her canine friends was so important to her and a huge part of her life, Jeannie's family and close friends know that she would want the recipient of this fund to meet certain qualifications. We take into consideration that each student's circumstance is different, but please be aware that we will rarely grant any exceptions to the following requirements.

Student applicants must:

- > Be a graduate from a high school located in Sullivan County, N.Y.
- > Have maintained 3.0 (or higher) GPA throughout their final two years of high school.
- > Be in good civil standing with the law.
- > Produce three references: (1) from a parent, (1) from a teacher and (1) from a member of their community.
- > Must be enrolled in a college of veterinary medicine (OR) medical science with a concentration in Oncology following graduation (provide documentation).
- > Provide documented proof of community service (one or a combination of the following: served within an animal rescue shelter, veterinarian office or animal caregiver profession [for veterinary science], hospitals, doctor's offices, nursing homes or any caregiver profession [for medical science]).
- > Submit the required essay as part of the application.
