

Monticello Teachers' Association Educational Scholarship

Award-The Monticello Teachers' Association Scholarship is a one-time grant payable to the recipient at the end of the first semester of the sophomore year with a certified transcript. Student must initiate contact with the current MTA President for scholarship payment processing at the end of the first semester/sophomore year. No parent(s)/legal guardians will be allowed to collect the scholarship award or communicate with the MTA about the award.

Requirements-Student must be a Monticello High School senior accepted into an accredited pre-service teacher training program at a college or university. Applicant must check with the guidance department on whether a specialized or trade schools/academies will be accepted for the scholarship. Consideration would be given to children of Monticello Teachers' Association members if there are no other student applicants.

Qualities-Scholarship, extra-curricular participation, character, leadership, service to school, and financial need.

Application

Applicants must submit:

1. Student information form
2. Student financial aid report
3. High school transcript
4. Write a letter regarding why you want to become a teacher and what special qualities that you possess in becoming one.
5. Submit one letter of recommendation from a Monticello Teachers' Association member who can attest to your interest in becoming a teacher.
