The completed application for an absentee ballot may be submitted by mail to the District Clerk, Janet Montes, 60 Jefferson Street, Suite 3, Monticello, New York 12701 or by email at [jmontes@k12mcsd.net](mailto:jmontes@k12mcsd.net). All voters who seek an absentee ballot are encouraged to submit their application as soon as possible. Applications for absentee ballots which are to be mailed to the voter must be received no later than seven (7) days before the elections and applications for absentee ballots that are to be personally delivered to the voter must be received no later than the day before the election.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Qualified voters who wish to apply for an absentee ballot for the July 28, 2020 school budget revote may use the application form available on the District's website, at <https://www.monticelloschools.net/board-of-education/voting-in-school-elections/> When completing and returning the application form, please observe the following special instructions:

- Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order 202.47, the potential for contraction of the COVID-19 virus is deemed a temporary illness for the purpose of eligibility to vote as an absentee voter in the school budget revote to be held July 28, 2020. Accordingly, persons applying as an absentee voter pursuant to Executive Order 202.47 must check the box marked "temporary illness or physical disability" in Section 1.
- Applicants who are requesting an absentee ballot for the July 28, 2020 school budget revote should check the box marked "Special School District Meeting" in Section 2.
- If you prefer to designate someone other than yourself to pick up your ballot for you at the District Clerk's office, you may do so by completing the required information in Section 6.
- The completed application for an absentee ballot may be submitted by mail to the District Clerk, Janet Montes, 60 Jefferson Street, Suite 3, Monticello, New York 12701 or by email at [jmontes@k12mcsd.net](mailto:jmontes@k12mcsd.net). Applications for absentee ballots which are to be mailed to the voter must be received no later than July 21, 2020 and applications for absentee ballots that are to be personally delivered to the voter must be received no later than July 27, 2020. All voters who seek an absentee ballot to vote in the July 28, 2020 school budget revote are encouraged to submit their application as soon as possible.
- To be counted, all completed absentee ballots must be received in the Office of the District Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on July 28, 2020.
