- C. Meeting agenda will be developed by the school principal and shared with the committee a day before the meeting.
- D. Notes/minutes and attendance will be recorded and maintained by the school principal.

5. REPORTING

- A. Each school committee will deliver a mid-year and end-of-year report to the Superintendent in the format specified.
- B. Mid-year report: Due by February 1, 2021.
- C. End-of-year report: Due by June 30, 2021.
